RE: JUDGING CHANGES – PRIMER #1

We are excited about the interest that the fair has been receiving to date – as well as the questions that we have received. We hope that we've been able to address most of the changes that will happen this year as a result of virtual aspect of the fair, however wanted to provide some additional clarifications.

Display

As the event will be virtual this year, students will have the opportunity to upload presentation materials in lieu of a display board. If students complete a display board as part of their class/school fair, photos of the display board are an acceptable submission. However, for those students that wish to submit alternate forms of presentation materials (videos, powerpoint, poster, etc.), this is acceptable. We encourage students to be innovative with their presentation of materials, as long as the materials present the project in its entirety, is self-explanatory, and logical. Revised judging forms are attached to this primer, with the revised sections identified in green.

Interview

Every effort will be made to allow for a seamless virtual interview from both the student and the judge's perspectives, however we expect there are likely to be a few hiccups as we move forward with this new format. We will identify to the judges that technical difficulties accessing the interview, or internet quality shouldn't impact the scores for students.

Logbooks

Logbooks are still required. If originally handwritten, a pdf scan, or photos of the logbook are acceptable. If originally an electronic copy, submission of this is acceptable, preferably as a single file.

We hope that this provides clarification on the judging criteria for this year's fair. If you have any further questions, please do not hesitate to contact the undersigned.
